WHAT DOES AUTOMOTIVE SERVICES FINANCE, INC. ("ASF") DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.
What?	<p>The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ■ Social Security number and credit history ■ credit scores and employment information ■ income and account transactions
How?	All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons ASF chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

For our everyday business purposes— such as to process your transactions, maintain your account(s), respond to court orders and legal investigations, or report to credit bureaus	Yes	No

What we do

How does ASF protect my personal information?

To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.

How does ASF collect my personal information?

We collect your personal information, for example, when you

- apply for financing or provide employment information
- pay your bills or give us your contact information
- give us your income information

We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.

Why can't I limit all sharing?

Federal law gives you the right to limit only

- sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness
- affiliates from using your information to market to you
- sharing for nonaffiliates to market to you

State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. See below for more on your rights under state law.

What happens when I limit sharing for an account I hold jointly with someone else?

Your choices will apply to everyone on your account - unless you tell us otherwise.

Definitions

Affiliates

Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Our affiliates include nonfinancial companies, such as those in which ASF shareholders have controlling interests.*

Nonaffiliates

Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies.

- *Nonaffiliates we share with can include credit reporting agencies, motor vehicle dealers, sellers of vehicle service contracts or other ancillary products, and those that assist in servicing your account.*

Joint marketing

A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you.

- *ASF doesn't jointly market.*

Other important information

STATE LAWS: CA & VT: Customers with California or Vermont mailing addresses are automatically considered to have limited sharing with nonaffiliates as described on Page 1 and ASF will not share such customers' personal information except when permitted or required by law.
